



## CASH 5 Rules

### **1. Name**

The name of this game is “CA\$H 5”.

### **2. Definitions**

- (a) The definitions in this section apply throughout these game rules.
- (b) “CA\$H 5 selection event” means a drawing or other selection event conducted to determine the winning combination of numbers in CA\$H 5.
- (c) “Winning CA\$H 5 numbers” means the five (5) numbers determined in a CA\$H 5 selection event and announced as winning numbers under section 7 of these game rules.
- (d) “EZmatch” is the name of the instant win add-on game.

### **3. Ticket Price**

The price of a CA\$H 5 ticket shall be one dollar (\$1) for each play.

### **4. Procedure for playing**

- (a) CA\$H 5
  - (1) A single play, applicable to a particular CA\$H 5 selection event, shall include the selection of five (5) numbers ranging from one (1) to forty-five (45).
  - (2) A draw game ticket for CA\$H 5 may represent one (1) or more plays.
  - (3) A valid ticket for a CA\$H 5 selection event must originate from the Commission. A ticket may only be issued after the information and purchaser elections required by this rule are entered into a terminal.
  - (4) A ticket is the only valid proof of a play and the only valid receipt for claiming a prize resulting from a CA\$H 5 selection event. A playslip shall have no pecuniary or prize value and shall not constitute evidence of purchase of a ticket or a play.
  - (5) Unless otherwise indicated on the ticket, a ticket for CA\$H 5 is effective for the next scheduled CA\$H 5 selection event. Subject to the restrictions of 65 IAC 7-2-6, the Commission may offer multi-draw tickets for CA\$H 5 that are effective for up to twenty-eight (28) consecutive selection events. The selection of the multi-draw option will apply to all boards played on that ticket.
  - (6) Sales of tickets for CA\$H 5 selection events shall be suspended prior to the time of the associated selection event at a time determined by the director.
  - (7) If a paper playslip is used to select a player’s numbers for a CA\$H 5 selection event, the playslip must have been issued by the Lottery and completed by hand. The playslip will be scanned by the terminal or keyed in by hand by the retailer.
  - (8) If a digital playslip is used from the Hoosier Lottery “myPLAYSLIP” app feature to select a player’s numbers for a CA\$H 5 selection event, the player must provide their device to be scanned on the terminal.

(9) A purchased ticket for CASH 5 shall be cancellable for up to sixty (60) minutes after the transaction or up to the CASH 5 selection event cutoff time, whichever is first. The draw ticket for CASH 5 can only be cancelled by the terminal from which it was sold.

(10) Coupons may be generated by terminals for certain purchases of tickets for CASH 5.

(b) EZmatch

(1) A single EZmatch play shall include five (5) unique numbers each ranging from one (1) to forty-five (45) and each is automatically generated.

(2) An EZmatch play will only be valid if the purchaser elects to play EZmatch and the terminal generated ticket says YES to affirmatively indicate that EZmatch play was elected. EZmatch numbers will only print on a CASH 5 ticket if the purchaser elects to participate in the EZmatch game. If the purchaser does not elect to play EZmatch, the terminal generated ticket says NO to indicate that the EZmatch play was not elected.

(3) EZmatch will only apply to the boards in which it is selected.

(4) If a player elects to play EZmatch, the terminal will generate separate tickets for each board selected.

(5) The selection of the multi-draw option for CASH 5 and an election of EZmatch play will result in EZmatch being applied for the first draw only.

(6) A ticket with an EZmatch win can be claimed immediately or wait until after the CASH 5 selection event. If an EZmatch winning ticket is claimed prior to the CASH 5 selection event for the date printed on the ticket of purchase, an exchange ticket, a valid instrument given in exchange for claiming an EZmatch prize won including the same CASH 5 numbers on the purchased ticket, will be issued and valid for the CASH 5 selection event printed on the ticket.

(7) A CASH 5 ticket in which EZmatch is purchased shall not be cancellable.

**5. Determination of estimated jackpot amount**

(a) The director or the director's designee shall announce the estimated cash jackpot prior to each CASH 5 selection event.

(b) The estimated lump sum jackpot amount for a particular CASH 5 selection event shall include:

(1) seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) in the first selection event following the last selection event in which a player won the jackpot prize;

(2) an additional increase, determined by the director, for each consecutive selection event after the first selection event following the last selection event in which a player won the jackpot prize; and

(3) a minimum jackpot roll of \$5,000.

**6. Determination of winning numbers**

Selection events for determination of winning numbers for CASH 5 shall be held daily in accordance with 65 IAC 7-1-8 at a time to be determined by the director.

**7. Determination of winners**

(a) CASH 5

(1) Each holder of a valid ticket for a CASH 5 selection event on which five (5) numbers in a play applicable to that selection event match the five (5) winning CASH 5



numbers is entitled to the jackpot amount or an equal share of the jackpot amount in the event multiple plays match the winning CA\$H 5 numbers.

- (2) Each holder of a valid ticket for a CA\$H 5 selection event on which four (4) numbers in a play applicable to that selection event match four (4) of the five (5) winning CA\$H 5 numbers is entitled to a set prize of two hundred dollars (\$200).
- (3) Each holder of a valid ticket for a CA\$H 5 selection event on which three (3) numbers in a play applicable to that selection event match three (3) of the five (5) winning CA\$H 5 numbers is entitled to a set prize of fifteen dollars (\$15).
- (4) Each holder of a valid ticket for a CA\$H 5 selection event on which two (2) numbers in a play applicable to that selection event match two (2) of the five (5) winning CA\$H 5 numbers is entitled to a set prize of a free CA\$H 5 Quick Pick ticket in the next scheduled CA\$H 5 selection event following the redemption of the winning ticket.

(b) EZmatch

(1) If any CA\$H 5 number(s) matches any number(s) of the add-on game, EZmatch, the ticket holder instantly wins the prize amount(s) shown next to the EZmatch number(s).

**8. Odds of winning**

(a) CA\$H 5

(1) The odds of a single play winning the jackpot prize in CA\$H 5 are approximately 1 in 1,221,759.

(2) The odds of a single play winning a two hundred dollar (\$200) prize in CA\$H 5 are approximately 1 in 6,109.

(3) The odds of a single play winning a fifteen dollar (\$15) prize in CA\$H 5 are approximately 1 in 157.

(4) The odds of a single play winning a free CA\$H 5 Quick Pick ticket are approximately 1 in 12.

(5) The overall odds of winning a prize in CA\$H 5 are approximately 1 in 11.

(b) EZmatch

(1) The odds of a single play winning a five hundred dollar (\$500) prize in EZmatch are approximately 1 in 84,000.

(2) The odds of a single play winning a two hundred fifty dollar (\$250) prize in EZmatch are approximately 1 in 42,000.

(3) The odds of a single play winning a one hundred dollar (\$100) prize in EZmatch are approximately 1 in 12,000.

(4) The odds of a single play winning a fifty dollar (\$50) prize in EZmatch are approximately 1 in 4,200.

(5) The odds of a single play winning a twenty dollar (\$20) prize in EZmatch are approximately 1 in 1,680.

(6) The odds of a single play winning a fifteen dollar (\$15) prize in EZmatch are approximately 1 in 840.

(7) The odds of a single play winning a ten dollar (\$10) prize in EZmatch are approximately 1 in 105.

(8) The odds of a single play winning a five dollar (\$5) prize in EZmatch are approximately 1 in 280.

(9) The odds of a single play winning a four dollar (\$4) prize in EZmatch are approximately 1 in 70.

(10) The odds of a single play winning a three dollar (\$3) prize in EZmatch are approximately 1 in 15.

(11) The odds of a single play winning a two dollar (\$2) prize in EZmatch are approximately 1 in 10.

(12) The overall odds of winning a prize in EZmatch are approximately 1 in 5.1.

**9. Payment of prizes**

(a) Each cash prize in CA\$H 5 shall be paid in a single lump sum payment or ticket.

(b) If a valid ticket for CA\$H 5 contains more than one (1) play entitled to a prize, the prize amounts for the winning plays shall be added together for purposes of claiming the prizes and determining whether the total prize amounts may be claimed from a retailer.

(c) Pari-mutuel prizes may be rounded down so the prizes may be paid in an equal share of the jackpot amount in the event multiple plays match the five (5) winning CA\$H 5 numbers.
