



**Game Number 2525
DIAMOND DASH**

1. The name of scratch-off game number 2525 is “DIAMOND DASH”.
2. Tickets in scratch-off game number 2525 shall sell for one dollar (\$1) per ticket, unless otherwise adjusted by temporary price reductions or other promotional activities conducted or authorized by the Commission.
3. (a) Each ticket in scratch-off game number 2525 shall contain twelve (12) play symbols under a scratch-off material covering the game play data area.
(b) Each play symbol includes a caption that corresponds with and verifies the play symbol as follows:



(d) If a question arises as to a play or prize symbol, the caption that corresponds with the play or prize symbol will be used for final clarification.

4. The:
 - (1) retailer validation code;
 - (2) game/pack/ticket number; and
 - (3) validation number;that appear on each ticket in scratch-off game number 2525 are for Commission or retailer use only and cannot be used or played as a play or prize symbol to win a prize.
5. (a) To play a ticket in scratch-off game number 2525, the ticket must be validly purchased and the scratch-off material covering the game play data area must be fully removed.



(b) Prizes are dependent on the number “DIAMOND” (DIAMOND) play symbols revealed in the game play area. Only the highest PRIZE won will be paid.



(i) If three (3) “DIAMOND” (DIAMOND) play symbols are revealed in the game play area, the ticket may be redeemed for one dollar (\$1).



(ii) If four (4) “DIAMOND” (DIAMOND) play symbols are revealed in the game play area, the ticket may be redeemed for two dollars (\$2).



(iii) If five (5) “DIAMOND” (DIAMOND) play symbols are revealed in the game play area, the ticket may be redeemed for three dollars (\$3).



(iv) If six (6) “DIAMOND” (DIAMOND) play symbols are revealed in the game play area, the ticket may be redeemed for five dollars (\$5).



(v) If seven (7) “DIAMOND” (DIAMOND) play symbols are revealed in the game play area, the ticket may be redeemed for ten dollars (\$10).



(vi) If eight (8) “DIAMOND” (DIAMOND) play symbols are revealed in the game play area, the ticket may be redeemed for fifty dollars (\$50).



(vii) If nine (9) “DIAMOND” (DIAMOND) play symbols are revealed in the game play area, the ticket may be redeemed for one hundred dollars (\$100).



(viii) If ten (10) “DIAMOND” (DIAMOND) play symbols are revealed in the game play area, the ticket may be redeemed for one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

6. (a) The approximate number of possible prizes and the estimated odds for each prize level are as follows:

(b) The number of prizes and the estimated odds provided in subsection (a) are calculated based on total print quantity of tickets. The actual number of prizes and the chances of winning a prize will vary as prizes are claimed.

(c) If there are reorders of the game, the ratio of prizes and total value of all prizes to the print quantity will be proportionately maintained so that the overall odds and prize payout percentage will approximate the values provided in subsection (a).
