Use a Feature Tower to Maximize Commissions

Change the games in your feature tower to promote the following Scratch-offs:

- \$10 Blazing Hot Bonus
- \$5 Holiday 7s
- \$2 Jingle all the Way
- \$1 Deck the Halls

Place the tower, containing product, near the bin set in the transaction area, closest to the primary register to:

- Attract new players
- Encourage existing players to try new price points

For retailers that DO NOT double-face games:

Games carried in the feature tower should be allocated from the planogram

 For example: You have a 32-bin set on the front counter and a 4-bin feature tower. A 36-bin planogram should be followed.



- Last Return Date: Last day inventory of a closing game can be returned through the Lottery terminal for retailer credit
- Last Date for Validations: Final day for winners to claim a prize on a closed game (180 days after the last return date)

All inventory of games listed in the above table should be given to your LSR for return processing before the displayed Last Return Date.

- After the return date:
 - Affected games/packs are no longer eligible for return
 - Any confirmed packs remaining in your location will be charged during the next invoicing period

Do you have inventory that needs to be returned? Here's how to find out:

- On the lottery terminal, print a Pack Status Report for each affected game by following the below steps:
 - Select "Scratch Function"
 - Select "Inventory Report"
 - Select "Pack Status" and enter the game number
- Print the report, and locate any listed packs

Note: Set aside all packs listed on the Pack Status Report for your LSR to return on their next visit.



You could earn a FREE Hoosier Lottery camouflage hat by keeping all access points full.

From December 2-31, Lottery Sales Representatives will award a Hoosier Lottery camouflage hat to retailers with full product at all selling locations. All Scratch-off dispensers, including bins, promotional towers, and Self-Service machines must be filled.

Best practices for keeping the counter bins and vending machines full:

- Check bin inventory after each shift. If inventory is low, place another pack behind the tickets for the next shift.
- Before closing, check all bins and vending machines to ensure there are no out-of-stocks for the next day.
- Tape packs together in the vending machine to help minimize out-of-stocks.
- If you do not have a game in stock, double-face the next best-selling game until your order arrives.



The busy holiday season is upon us, bringing more gift-giving customers into your store and an opportunity to increase Sales and your earned commission.

To ensure retailers have enough Scratch-off inventory to cover the anticipated holiday demand, we include extra packs of new games as part of game launch allocation as well as best sellers through your replenishments. This means there will be more holiday game inventory in your stores to meet the needs of your customers, drive sales and manage out-of-stocks.

During this season, the Instant Ticket Specialist (ITS) department will maintain replenishment orders and work to ensure that orders are created and available at retail, you may experience an increase in deliveries as they work ahead to cover holidays and days we will not deliver.

The Hoosier Lottery and/or UPS will be closed on the following days.
These closures will affect ITS availability and UPS delivery.



If you find inventory running low due to high sales, check your terminal reports to see if an order is en route. If needed call the ITS department, they are available Monday through Friday 7:30AM to 5:00PM ET at (800) 955-6886. The ordering system is based on validations, often during the holiday season Scratch-offs are used for gift-giving and the validations do not occur until after the holiday. Please call ITS for large runs from individual packs or full packs to ensure you have the needed inventory for holiday sales.

Benefits of Taping Multiple Scratch-off Packs Together in Self-Service Machines:

- Reduce out-of-stocks by maintaining proper inventory levels on your best-selling games
- Increase your lottery sales and commissions
- Keep players happy and returning to your store
- Minimize inventory in your office or locked safe, maximizing the number of Scratch-offs available for sale
- Reduce line at Customer Service for lottery purchases

Taping Logic and "How To":

- Pull the Last 4 Weeks Sales Report from the Self-Service machine, indicating how many packs of a game are sold every four weeks, and determine how many packs to load
 - Each bin can accommodate only a certain number of tickets/packs depending on the price point (see chart to the right)
 - Overloading the machine could cause tickets to jam
- Print off an Inventory Report before you load any new packs to confirm beginning inventory is correct
- Activate all packs you intend to load into the Self-Service machine

Make sure to place the last ticket from the new pack (highest ticket #) to the first ticket of the existing pack (# 000)






- 4. For each bin you are loading a taped pack:
 - a. Scan the barcode on bin to load
 - b. Scan the new Scratch-off pack
 - c. Peel one strip of tape from the roll and place the perforated portion of tape over the area where the tickets line up. The tape can be clear or have a red stripe
 - d. On properly taped packs, the perforations from both packs are within the red stripe
- e. Fold one pack on top of the other and place it inside the Self-Service machine and follow the loading procedures for that type of machine. Depending on the brand of ITVM you have, you may need to manually add/adjust the number of books in the bins to account for the extra inventory
- Print off a final **Inventory Report** to ensure inventory is correct after loading

Ask your Lottery Sales Representative how you or your staff can be trained on taping packs together today!

They can also make sure you have the perforated tape, designed for the Self-Service machine.

Tips For Fulfilling Last Minute Sales:

- Fill your Feature Tower with Holiday-themed Scratch-offs and place near the bin set in the transaction area, closest to the primary register
 - o Remember, Holiday Scratch-offs are perfect for gifts or gift toppers
- Never leave a bin empty at the counter or in a vending machine
 - o Tape packs together in vending machines to reduce loading time and to ensure your best-selling games are always in-stock
- Offer ticket envelopes (pictured below) to customers purchasing tickets as gifts for adults 18 and older



Debit Card Best Practices

Debit cards are approved forms of payment for Lottery at the discretion of the retailer. As a best practice and security measure, hand keying a debit card number is highly discouraged.

When accepting debit card payments, it is a best practice to ensure that the majority of your customers' debit card information is acquired by swiping, dipping or tapping and that you settle your terminal daily. The less risk that is involved in acquiring, transmitting, and processing your customers' debit card information, the lower your transaction fees will be.



One of the reasons a card might not be readable through the swipe, dip, or tap functions is that it may be counterfeit. When a card number is manually keyed in, there is no way for the debit card processing company to know whether the card was actually present for the transaction.

- If a transaction is completed by keying card information in manually, the liability shifts back to the merchant if a chargeback is filed or the cardholder claims fraud
- Since fraudulent use of debit card numbers costs companies millions of dollars each year, the card processing companies charge a higher fee for those transactions
 - O In return, that increase is then passed along to merchants processing the transaction
- By updating your debit card hardware and software to accept EMV chip cards, it eases your liability for fraudulent transactions and chargebacks1

As a Lottery best practice, never manually key in transactions and only accept card payments through swipe, dip or tap methods.


The 24 and 28 bin planograms below can be torn out and posted inside the Self-Service machines as a convenient reference.
