



**Game Number 2460  
SKEE-BALL®**

1. The name of scratch-off game number 2460 is “SKEE-BALL®”.
2. Tickets in scratch-off game number 2460 shall sell for two dollars (\$2) per ticket, unless otherwise adjusted by temporary price reductions or other promotional activities conducted or authorized by the Commission.

3. (a) Each ticket in scratch-off game number 2460 shall contain a total of thirty-one (31) symbols under a scratch-off material covering the game play data area. Each ticket in scratch-off game number 2469 shall be divided into four (4) distinct areas as follows:

(1) A game play area labeled “SKEE-BALL BOARD” that contains eighteen (18) play symbols.

(2) An area labeled as “YOUR SHOT NUMBERS” that contains ten (10) play symbols.

- The available play symbols appearing in the “SKEE-BALL BOARD” and in the “YOUR SHOT NUMBERS” areas are as follows:

(3) An area labeled as “QUICK TOTAL” that contains three (3) symbols. The available symbols appearing in the “QUICK TOTAL” area are as follows:

0 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9

(4) An area labeled as “PRIZE KEY.”

5. (a) To play a ticket in scratch-off game number 2460, the ticket must be validly purchased and the scratch-off material covering the game play data area

must be fully removed.

(b) A prize can be won by matching play symbols revealed in the “YOUR SHOT NUMBERS” play area to the play symbols located in the area labeled “SKEE-BALL BOARD.” Each matched “YOUR SHOT NUMBER” will correspond to an individual point value displayed on the “SKEE-BALL BOARD.” If the sum of the “POINTS” that correspond to the matched “YOUR SHOT NUMBERS” on the “SKEE-BALL BOARD” is greater than one-hundred fifty (150) “POINTS”, the ticket may be redeemed for the prize amount indicated on the “PRIZE KEY” that corresponds to the matched point value.

(c) A sum of “POINTS” to the matched “YOUR SHOT NUMBERS” to the “SKEE-BALL BOARD” play symbols can be revealed in the area labeled “QUICK TOTAL” and cannot be used to increase your “POINT” total. Only the highest prize won will be paid per ticket.

6. (a) The approximate number of possible prizes and the estimated odds for each prize level are as follows:

(b) The number of prizes and the estimated odds provided in subsection (a) are calculated based on total print quantity of tickets. The actual number of prizes and the chances of winning a prize will vary as prizes are claimed.

(c) If there are reorders of the game, the ratio of prizes and total value of all prizes to the print quantity will be proportionately maintained so that the overall odds and prize payout percentage will approximate the values provided in subsection (a).
