



Hoosier Lotto Game Rules

1. Name

The name of this draw game is "Hoosier Lotto".

2. Definitions

- (a) The definitions in this section apply throughout these game rules.
- (b) "Hoosier Lotto selection event" means a drawing or other selection event conducted to determine the winning combination of characters in Hoosier Lotto.
- (c) "Winning Hoosier Lotto numbers" means the six (6) numbers determined in a Hoosier Lotto selection event and announced as winning numbers under section 9 of these game rules.

3. Ticket price

The price of a ticket for Hoosier Lotto shall be one dollar (\$1) for each play.

4. Procedure for playing

- (a) A single play, applicable to a particular Hoosier Lotto selection event, shall include the selection of six (6) numbers ranging from one (1) to forty-eight (48).
- (b) A ticket for Hoosier Lotto may represent one (1) or more plays.
- (c) A valid ticket for a Hoosier Lotto selection event must originate from the commission. A ticket may only be issued after the information and purchaser elections required by this rule are entered into a terminal.
- (d) A ticket is the only valid proof of a play and the only valid receipt for claiming a prize in Hoosier Lotto. A play slip shall have no pecuniary or prize value and shall not constitute evidence of purchase of a ticket or a play.
- (e) Unless otherwise indicated on the ticket, a ticket for Hoosier Lotto is effective for the next scheduled Hoosier Lotto selection event.
- (f) Subject to the restrictions of 65 IAC 7-1-6, the commission may offer multi-draw tickets for Hoosier Lotto that are effective for up to ten (10) consecutive selection events.
- (g) Sales of tickets for Hoosier Lotto shall be suspended prior to the time of each Hoosier Lotto selection event at a time determined by the director.
- (h) If a play slip is used to select a player's numbers for a Hoosier Lotto selection event, the play slip must have been issued by the lottery and completed by hand. The play slip will be scanned by the terminal or keyed in by hand by the retailer.
- (i) The director may provide for the generation of entry tickets from terminals for certain purchases of tickets for Hoosier Lotto.

5. Winnings pool

The winnings pool for Hoosier Lotto shall be equal to approximately fifty-three and two-tenths percent (53.2%) of total Hoosier Lotto sales receipts for the selection event.

6. Estimated annuity jackpot amount

(a) The director or the director's designee shall announce the estimated annuity jackpot amount prior to each Hoosier Lotto selection event.

(b) The estimated annuity jackpot amount for a particular Hoosier Lotto selection event shall include:

(1) one million dollars (\$1,000,000) in the first and second consecutive selection events following the last selection event in which a player won the jackpot prize; and

(2) an additional five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for each consecutive selection event after the second selection event following the last selection event in which a player won the jackpot prize.

7. Determination of single payment prize amounts

(a) The lump sum jackpot amount applicable to a particular Hoosier Lotto selection event shall include:

(1) seventy-four and eight-tenths percent (74.8%) of the winnings pool for the selection event; and

(2) the lump sum jackpot amounts, if any, applicable to selection events preceding the particular selection event and following the last selection event in which players won the jackpot prize.

(b) Four and two-tenths percent (4.2%) of the winnings pool shall be allocated among players who have matched five (5) of the six (6) winning Hoosier Lotto numbers.

(c) Nine percent (9%) of the winnings pool shall be allocated among players who have matched four (4) of the six (6) winning Hoosier Lotto numbers.

(d) The remaining balance of the winnings pool shall first be applied to the set prizes of three dollars (\$3) paid to players who have matched three (3) of the six (6) winning Hoosier Lotto numbers.

(e) The winnings pool is not affected by set prizes of free quick picks for a future Hoosier Lotto drawing, which is awarded to players who have matched two (2) of the six (6) winning Hoosier Lotto numbers.

8. Determination of winning numbers

Selection events for determination of winning numbers for Hoosier Lotto shall be held on Wednesday and Saturday evenings in accordance with 65 IAC 7-1-8 at a time to be determined by the director.

9. Determination of winners

(a) Each holder of a valid ticket for a Hoosier Lotto selection event on which six (6) numbers in a play applicable to that selection event match the six (6) winning Hoosier Lotto numbers is entitled to the jackpot amount or an equal share of the jackpot amount in the event multiple plays match the winning Hoosier Lotto numbers.

(b) Each holder of a valid ticket for a Hoosier Lotto selection event on which five (5) numbers in a play applicable to that selection event match five (5) of the six (6) winning Hoosier Lotto numbers is entitled to an equal share of the allocable percentage of the winnings pool.

(c) Each holder of a valid ticket for a Hoosier Lotto selection event on which four (4) numbers in a play applicable to that selection event match four (4) of the six (6) winning Hoosier Lotto numbers is entitled to an equal share of the allocable percentage of the winnings pool.

(d) Each holder of a valid ticket for a Hoosier Lotto selection event on which three (3) numbers in a play applicable to that selection event match three (3) of the six (6) winning Hoosier Lotto numbers is entitled to a set prize of three dollars (\$3).

(e) Each holder of a valid ticket for a Hoosier Lotto selection event on which two (2) numbers in a play applicable to that selection event match two (2) of the six (6) winning Hoosier Lotto numbers is entitled to a set prize of a free Hoosier Lotto quick pick in the next scheduled Hoosier Lotto selection event.

10. Payment options; player election

(a) Players are required to select a payment option for distribution of the jackpot prize. The following payment options are available:

(1) A single lump sum payment of the jackpot amount or the player's share of the lump sum jackpot amount as calculated in section 7(a) of these game rules.

(2) Thirty (30) annual payments until the total payments equal the annuity jackpot amount or the player's share of the annuity jackpot amount as estimated in section 6 of these game rules.

(b) A jackpot prize claimant shall have sixty (60) days from the day the prize claimant becomes entitled to receive the jackpot amount or a share of the jackpot amount to select a payment option. The election must be in writing and on a form authorized by the commission. An election under this subsection cannot be revoked, withdrawn, or otherwise modified. The election of the prize claimant shall apply to all prize winners of that jackpot prize.

(c) If a prize claimant fails to select a payment option, the jackpot amount shall be paid out in a single lump sum payment.

(d) The commission, director, agents, or employees of the commission shall not be responsible for differences in the advertised or estimated jackpot amount or the amount paid to the player due to changes in the price of securities occurring between the drawing and payment dates.

(e) The director may, in the director's discretion and despite the player's selection, require a single lump sum payment if the winnings pool is insufficient to obtain securities for an annuity payment stream at a reasonable cost.

11. Payment of prizes

(a) Payments arising out of the jackpot amount shall be made in accordance with the player's selected payment option in accordance with section 10 of these game rules.

(b) If a valid ticket for Hoosier Lotto contains more than one (1) play entitled to a prize, the prize amounts for the winning plays shall be added together for purposes of claiming the prizes and determining whether the total prize amounts may be claimed from a retailer.

(c) An annuity jackpot prize or any share of a jackpot prize may be rounded to facilitate the purchase of an appropriate funding mechanism. Breakage (the remainder after division or rounding) on a jackpot prize shall be added to the first payment. Pari-

mutuel prizes may be rounded down so that the prizes may be paid in multiples of whole dollars. Breakage resulting from rounding down pari-mutuel prizes shall be carried forward to the jackpot amount portion of the winnings pool for the next Hoosier Lotto selection event.

12. Odds of winning

(a) The odds of a single play winning the jackpot prize in Hoosier Lotto are approximately 1:12,271,512.

(b) The odds of a single play winning a pari-mutuel prize in Hoosier Lotto by matching five (5) of the winning Hoosier Lotto numbers are approximately 1:48,696.

(c) The odds of a single play winning a pari-mutuel prize in Hoosier Lotto by matching four (4) of the winning Hoosier Lotto numbers are approximately 1:950.

(d) The odds of a single play winning a three dollar (\$3) prize in Hoosier Lotto by matching three (3) of the winning Hoosier Lotto numbers are approximately 1:53.

(e) The odds of a single play winning a free Hoosier Lotto quick pick prize in Hoosier Lotto by matching two (2) of the winning Hoosier Lotto numbers are approximately 1:7.

(f) The overall odds of winning a prize in Hoosier Lotto are approximately 1:6.39.

13. Add-on name

The name of this instant win draw game add-on for Hoosier Lotto is "EZmatch".

14. Add-on ticket price

The price for an EZmatch play shall be one dollar (\$1) per each play.

15. Procedure for playing add-on

(a) A single EZmatch play shall include six (6) unique numbers each ranging from one (1) to forty-eight (48) and each automatically generated.

(b) An EZmatch play will only be valid if the purchaser elects to play EZmatch and the terminal generated ticket says YES to affirmatively indicate that the EZmatch play was elected. EZmatch numbers will only print on a Hoosier Lotto ticket if the player elects to participate in the EZmatch game. If the purchaser does not elect to play EZmatch, the terminal generated ticket says NO to indicate that the EZmatch play was not elected.

(c) EZmatch will only apply to the boards in which it is selected.

(d) If a player elects to play multiple boards, the terminal will generate separate tickets for each board selected.

(e) The selection of the multi-draw option for Hoosier Lotto and an election of the EZmatch play will result in EZmatch being applied to the first draw only.

(f) A ticket may win on both Hoosier Lotto and EZmatch.

(g) A ticket with an EZmatch win can be claimed immediately or wait until after the Hoosier Lotto selection event. If an EZmatch winning ticket is claimed prior to the Hoosier Lotto selection event for the date printed on the ticket of purchase, an exchange ticket, a valid instrument given in exchange for claiming an EZmatch prize won including the same Hoosier Lotto numbers on the purchased ticket, will be issued and valid for the next selection event.

(h) A ticket in which Hoosier Lotto and EZmatch are purchased shall not be cancelable.

16. Determination of add-on winners

If any Hoosier Lotto number(s) on the ticket matches any number(s) of the add-on game, EZmatch, the ticket holder instantly wins the prize amount(s) shown next to the EZmatch number(s).

17. Payment of add-on prizes

(a) If the Hoosier Lotto selection event for the date printed on the ticket of purchase has not occurred and a valid Hoosier Lotto and EZmatch ticket contains one (1) play entitled to an EZmatch prize, the EZmatch prize can be claimed immediately.

(b) If the Hoosier Lotto selection event for the date printed on the ticket of purchase has occurred and a valid Hoosier Lotto and EZmatch ticket contains one (1) play entitled to a Hoosier Lotto prize and one (1) play entitled to an EZmatch prize, the prize amounts for the winning plays shall be added together for purposes of claiming the prizes and determining whether the total prize amounts may be claimed from a retailer.

18. Odds of winning the add-on

(a) The odds of a single play winning a five hundred dollar (\$500) prize in EZmatch are approximately 1:84,000.

(b) The odds of a single play winning a two hundred fifty dollar (\$250) prize in EZmatch are approximately 1:42,000.

(c) The odds of a single play winning a one hundred dollar (\$100) prize in EZmatch are approximately 1:12,000.

(d) The odds of a single play winning a fifty dollar (\$50) prize in EZmatch are approximately 1:4,200.

(e) The odds of a single play winning a twenty dollar (\$20) prize in EZmatch are approximately 1:1,680.

(f) The odds of a single play winning a fifteen dollar (\$15) prize in EZmatch are approximately 1:840.

(g) The odds of a single play winning a ten dollar (\$10) prize in EZmatch are approximately 1:105.

(h) The odds of a single play winning a five dollar (\$5) prize in EZmatch are approximately 1:280.

(i) The odds of a single play winning a four dollar (\$4) prize in EZmatch are approximately 1:70.

(j) The odds of a single play winning a three dollar (\$3) prize in EZmatch are approximately 1:15.

(k) The odds of a single play winning a two dollar (\$2) prize in EZmatch are approximately 1:10.

(l) The overall odds of winning a prize in EZmatch are approximately 1:5.1.
