



**RULES AND PROCEDURES GOVERNING THE
WHEEL OF FORTUNE® 2ND CHANCE PROMOTION**

The State Lottery Commission of Indiana (“Hoosier Lottery” or “Lottery”), by its Executive Director, hereby promulgates these rules and procedures (“Official Rules”) governing the Wheel of Fortune 2nd Chance Promotion (“Promotion”), authorized pursuant to 65 IAC 1-7-1. This Promotion is open to players who become eligible for participation by complying with these rules and procedures.

A. PURPOSE

The Promotion will be conducted to support the Hoosier Lottery Wheel of Fortune® Scratch-off ticket (game number 2165). One (1) drawing will be held to award four (4) winners the Grand Prize Trip Package (Grand Prize). The Grand Prize includes Round trip airfare for two (2) from any major commercial Indiana airport to Los Angeles, CA, four (4) nights deluxe accommodations at a Los Angeles hotel, ground transportation to and from the Los Angeles airport and hotel, ground transportation to and from Sony Studios and hotel, one thousand dollars (\$1,000) spending money, a bus tour of Hollywood for two (2), two (2) tickets to a welcome reception hosted on the first night of the trip, two (2) tickets to a non-broadcast, lottery players-only taping of Wheel of Fortune where each winner shall win a cash prize and may have the opportunity to participate for a chance to win up to one million dollars (\$1,000,000).

B. PROMOTION PERIOD

The Promotion Period begins at 4:30 am (ET) on Tuesday, July 5, 2016 and ends on the final entry deadline, Sunday, November 13, 2016, at 11:59 pm (ET) with the final drawing being held on or about Wednesday, November 16, 2016.

C. DRAWINGS AND PRIZE DESCRIPTIONS

1. Promotion will be conducted by the Hoosier Lottery in accordance with all applicable statutes, rules and drawing procedures.
2. Promotion drawings will occur on or about the following days for the listed prizes:

D. ELIGIBILITY

1. This Promotion is open to players eighteen (18) years of age or older who have a current **mylottery** account in good standing.
2. A player may enter the Promotion more than once as long as each entry is with a unique non-winning qualified scratch-off ticket. However, only one (1) prize per household will be allowed.
3. State Lottery Commission of Indiana members, officers, and employees, and any relative(s) residing in the same household of such Hoosier Lottery member, officer, or employee are not eligible to participate in this Promotion.
4. Members, directors, officers, or employees of a major procurement vendor of the Hoosier Lottery, including IGT Indiana, LLC, and any relative(s) residing in the same household of such persons are not eligible to participate in this Promotion.
5. Owners, officers, directors, or employees of licensed Hoosier Lottery retailers may not enter tickets sold at any retail location where they are employed or have management responsibilities.

E. HOW TO ENTER

1. To enter, a player must go to hoosierlottery.com and sign into their **mylottery** account. If a player does not have a **mylottery** account, they must select “sign up now” to register and complete the **mylottery** account sign up, **which is free**.
2. The player must follow the instructions for entering non-winning \$5 Wheel of Fortune Scratch-off ticket(s). For the purposes of this Promotion, a “non-winning ticket” is defined as a ticket, validly purchased from a Hoosier Lottery retailer location or purchased or received directly from the Hoosier Lottery, which does not have a winning prize combination. The player must enter from the front of the ticket the 6-character alphanumeric entry code found under the scratch-off material covering the game play data area.
3. An automated “Thank You” page will notify the player of a completed entry into the Promotion. The “Thank You” notification is only evidence that an entry has been received and does not indicate that the entry is valid.
4. All non-winning tickets whose numbers are submitted as a Promotion Entry **must be retained**. In order to claim a prize, the entrant will be required to submit the eligible ticket to the Hoosier Lottery. The ticket must be intact and must not be mutilated, defaced, damaged, altered, reconstituted or tampered with in any manner.
5. Each entry must contain current and valid information. The Hoosier Lottery will not change or update entry information for an entry that has already been submitted.

6. All entries that are submitted in the manner as described in these official rules will be eligible for entry in this Promotion. Hand delivered or mailed in entries will not be accepted for this Promotion and will be deemed invalid and destroyed.

F. ODDS OF WINNING

The odds of winning any prize are dependent upon the total number of valid entries entered at the time of a drawing.

G. GAME SHOW & PRIZE DETAILS

1. Each winner of a Grand Prize shall have a chance to be selected as a contestant in a non-broadcast version of the Wheel of Fortune Game show ("Game Show Contestant") with Pat Sajak and Vanna White as hosts ("the Non-Broadcast TV Show"). The Non-Broadcast TV Show shall be part of a multi-state promotion, and Grand Prize trip winners from other state lotteries shall be participating in the Non-Broadcast TV Show as Game Show Contestants (the "Multistate Winners"). During the Non-Broadcast TV Show, each Game Show contestant may have the chance to play Wheel of Fortune and to win up to one million dollars (\$1,000,000) in prizes.
2. Grand Prize Trip winners and Multistate Winners who are not selected as Game Show Contestants shall be randomly assigned to teams ("Game Show Team") with each Game Show Contestant named as the team captain. Each Game Show Team shall win the equivalent cash prize as their team captain. Team prizes shall be split evenly among the Game Show Team members. Prizes awarded on the Non-Broadcast TV Show shall be cash only; no trips or merchandise shall be awarded as prizes. Each Grand Prize trip package Winner shall receive a DVD of the Non-Broadcast Show.
3. The Grand Prize winners shall also have a chance to spin the Wheel of Fortune wheel one (1) time (the "Wheel Spin") to win a cash prize ranging from three hundred dollars (\$300) up to twenty five hundred dollars (\$2,500).
4. If a Grand Prize winner or transferee is unable to attend the Non-Broadcast TV Show, a designee appointed by the Grand Prize winner shall fill in as proxy at the Non-Broadcast TV Show. In the event that a Grand Prize winner is unable to appoint a proxy, a Hoosier Lottery representative shall fill in as a proxy for the Grand Prize winner at the Non-Broadcast TV Show. Any cash prize(s) won by any such proxy shall be awarded to the Grand Prize winner who appointed the proxy or on whose behalf the proxy was appointed.
5. Grand Prize does not include: mileage, insurance, gratuities, meals, parking fees, excess baggage fees, alcoholic beverages, any items not expressly specified and personal expenses such as telephone calls, valet service, laundry, and the like, revision or cancellation fees which may be charged by the hotel or other suppliers.
6. Unless otherwise specified by the Hoosier Lottery, if a Grand Prize winner fails to arrive for the scheduled flight or fails to check into the hotel, the balance of the Grand Prize shall be forfeited, with the exception of the one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) spending money.
7. The Grand Prize winner, designee or guests must have a valid credit card or shall be required to post cash deposits for incidentals in order to check into the hotel, unless other arrangements are made directly with the hotel.
8. The Grand Prize is transferable with the consent of the Hoosier Lottery. In the event of a transfer, the original Grand Prize Trip Package Winner shall receive the check for the one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) spending money, and the applicable tax liability and debt set off for the Grand Prize shall be reported in the name of such original Grand Prize winner.

H. WINNER ANNOUNCEMENT AND CLAIMING OF PRIZE

1. Winning entries drawn for this Promotion will be notified in writing via email and/or via phone if phone number is provided. Winners who fail to complete and return all requested forms and provide the physical ticket within five (5) business days will automatically forfeit their prize and the next alternate will be selected.
2. Upon timely presentation of winner information including the physical ticket used for entry, the entry will be validated and eligibility will be verified as described in Section D (“Eligibility”).
3. If any entry is disqualified during the initial drawing or in the winner notification process, the next alternate will be contacted by Hoosier Lottery. Alternates have five (5) business days to claim their prize.
4. After Winner Verification and Winner Authorization are complete, winner information will be posted on hoosierlottery.com.
5. Grand Prize must be claimed at Hoosier Lottery Prize Payment at Headquarters, Hoosier Lottery Regional Prize Payment Centers or by mail.
6. Once Winner Verification is complete, IGT shall be notified to initiate the Grand Prize fulfillment process. IGT, who will be responsible for fulfilling the Grand Prize, will contact with winner within ten (10) business days to begin making travel arrangements.
7. Liability waivers must be signed, and provided to the Lottery, by ALL participants, including the Grand Prize Winner’s guest, prior to any awarded travel taking place.
8. For all winners for this Promotion, the Lottery is required to determine if a prize winner has an outstanding debt to the state, owes delinquent taxes, or is past due on child support pursuant to IC 4-30-11-11. Debts will be checked for at the time of claim, and prior to any additional winnings won during the Grand Prize trip being paid.
 - a. If a debt is discovered for one of the Grand Prize winners, the winner will be required to pay the balance of debt prior to the claim deadline and being awarded the Prize Package. If the winner does not pay the outstanding debt, he or she will forfeit the prize and an alternate will be contacted.
9. The Hoosier Lottery will withhold on the winners’ behalf applicable federal and state income withholding taxes on the value of the Grand Prize trip expense. All other costs, taxes (including all state and federal taxes), fees and expenses associated with the acceptance and use of any element of a prize, which are not paid by the Hoosier Lottery, are the sole responsibility of the winner. The Lottery will provide the winner a W2-G for tax reporting purposes for the Grand Prize trip expense.
10. IGT, who will fulfil the Grand Prize trip will withhold and deposit on the winners’ behalf applicable federal and state income withholding taxes on the value of any prize money won on the trip. All other costs, taxes (including all state and federal taxes), fees and expenses associated with any prize won on the trip, are the sole responsibility of the winner. IGT will provide the winner a W2-G for tax reporting purposes for prizes of \$600 or more won on the trip.
11. Each Promotion winner may be required to participate in publicity and marketing efforts. Examples include, but are not limited to, an interview with Hoosier Lottery individuals, television, radio and/or newspaper reporters and/or photographers/videographers. This information may be used in future media, the Hoosier Lottery’s website, in store Point of Purchase materials or other marketing efforts without consent or notice.

I. GENERAL RULES AND PROVISIONS

1. The rules and procedures set forth in these Official Rules shall govern this Promotion. These rules may be amended at any time by the Executive Director or her designee of the Hoosier Lottery without advance notice.

2. The Executive Director or her designee may, at any time, announce a suspension or termination of this Promotion without advance notice and in the Executive Director's sole discretion, at which point no further entries will be accepted and no additional Prizes shall be awarded. The Hoosier Lottery, the Executive Director, nor any employee of the Hoosier Lottery, IGT Indiana or member of the State Lottery Commission of Indiana, shall have any liability whatsoever for any such termination.
3. By participating in the Promotion each person agrees to comply with and abide by Indiana law, rules, and regulations as well as the terms and conditions of the Lottery website and all final decisions, policies, or procedures of the Hoosier Lottery in relation to the conduct of this Promotion. Any dispute arising which relates to any aspect of this Promotion shall be governed by the laws of Indiana.
4. The Hoosier Lottery and its agents are not responsible for error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operations, theft or destruction, unauthorized access to or alterations of entry materials, failure to receive entry, winner information, or other contest information for any reason whatsoever.
5. The Hoosier Lottery is not responsible for issues with **mylottery** account accessibility or Promotion entries due to technical problems associated to software, hardware compatibility or internet access.
6. By entering this Promotion, all Promotion participants agree to indemnify, hold harmless, and waive any claims against the Hoosier Lottery, including IGT, and any of their affiliates, associates, directors, officers, agents, representatives and assigns arising directly or indirectly, out of, or in any way connected with, this Promotion or the prizes awarded in connection therewith.
