



**Game Number 2117
WINDIANA**

1. The name of scratch-off game number 2117 is “WINDIANA”.
2. Tickets in scratch-off game number 2117 have a promotional value of one dollar (\$1) and shall be given away for prizes at promotional activities conducted or authorized by the Commission.
3. (a) Each ticket in scratch-off game number 2117 shall contain a total of five (5) play symbols and five (5) prize symbols under a scratch-off material covering the game play data area.

(b) Each play symbol includes a caption that corresponds with and verifies the play symbol as follows:



(c) Each prize symbol includes a caption that corresponds with and verifies the prize symbol as follows:



(d) If a question arises as to a play or prize symbol, the caption that corresponds with the play or prize symbol will be used for final clarification.


4. The:
 - (1) retailer validation code;
 - (2) game/pack/ticket number; and
 - (3) validation number;
 that appears on each ticket in scratch-off game number 2117 are for Commission or retailer use only and cannot be used or played as a play or prize symbol to win a prize.

5. (a) To play a ticket in scratch-off game number 2117, the scratch-off material covering the game play data area must be fully removed.

(b) If a “ WIN” (LOTTERY) symbol is revealed in the play area, the ticket may be redeemed for a prize in the amount represented by the prize symbol that is located directly below and corresponding with the “ WIN” (LOTTERY) play symbol.

(1) If a dollar amount is revealed and corresponds with the winning “ WIN” (LOTTERY) play symbol, then the ticket may be redeemed for the dollar amount represented by the prize symbol.

(2) If a “ TICKET” (SCRATCH OFF TICKET) prize symbol is revealed and corresponds with the winning “ WIN” (LOTTERY) play symbol, then the ticket may be redeemed for a one dollar (\$1) Hoosier Lottery Scratch-off ticket.

(3) If a “ QP TICKET” (HOOSIER LOTTO QP TICKET) prize symbol is revealed and corresponds with the winning “ WIN” (LOTTERY) play symbol, then the ticket may be redeemed for a two dollar (\$2) Hoosier Lotto quick pick ticket.

(4) If a “ QP TICKET” (CASH 5 QP TICKET) prize symbol is revealed and corresponds with the winning “ WIN” (LOTTERY) play symbol, then the ticket may be redeemed for a one dollar (\$1) Cash 5 quick pick ticket.

(5) If a “ QP TICKET” (MEGA MILLION QP TICKET) prize symbol is revealed and corresponds with the winning “ WIN” (LOTTERY) play symbol, then the ticket may be redeemed for a one dollar (\$1) Mega Millions quick pick ticket.

(6) If a “ QP TICKET” (POWER BALL QP TICKET) prize symbol is revealed and corresponds with the winning “ WIN” (LOTTERY) play symbol, then the ticket may be redeemed for a two dollar (\$2) Powerball quick pick ticket.

6. (a) The approximate number of possible prizes and the estimated odds for each prize level are as follows:

Total value of all prizes*: **\$128,904.19**
Prize payout: **60.59%**

Approximate print quantity: **237,600 ±2%**

(b) The number of prizes and the estimated odds provided in subsection (a) are calculated based on print quantity. The actual number of prizes and the chances of winning a prize will vary depending on the actual quantity of tickets printed and as prizes are claimed.

(c) Total prize payout includes retail value of all free ticket prizes.

(d) If the print quantity is changed during production of this game or due to subsequent reorders of the game, the ratio of prizes and total value of all prizes to the print quantity will be proportionately maintained so that the overall odds and prize payout percentage will approximate the values provided in subsection (a).
