



**RULES AND PROCEDURES GOVERNING THE
ALL CASH MILLIONS (LIMITED) 2ND CHANCE PROMOTION**

The State Lottery Commission of Indiana (“Hoosier Lottery” or “Lottery”), by its Executive Director, hereby promulgates these rules and procedures (“Official Rules”) governing the All Cash Millions (Limited) 2nd Chance Promotion (“Promotion”), authorized pursuant to 65 IAC 1-7-1. This Promotion is open to players who become eligible for participation by complying with these rules and procedures.

A. PURPOSE

The Promotion will be conducted to support the Hoosier Lottery \$30 All Cash Millions (Limited) Scratch-off ticket (game number 2154). One (1) drawing will be conducted to award five (5) winners five hundred dollars (\$500) each. One (1) drawing will be conducted to award five (5) winners five hundred dollars (\$500) each and an entry in the finalist drawing event. The finalist drawing event will be held at a date and time to be determined by the Hoosier Lottery. At the finalist drawing event, one (1) winner of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) will be selected from the pool of the five (5) finalists selected in the preliminary drawing.

B. PROMOTION PERIOD

The Promotion Period begins at 4:30 am (ET) on Tuesday, September 6, 2016 and ends on the entry deadline, Sunday, August 27, 2017, at 11:59 pm (ET) with the drawing being held on or about Wednesday, August 30, 2017.

C. DRAWINGS AND PRIZE DESCRIPTIONS

1. Promotion will be conducted by the Hoosier Lottery in accordance with all applicable statutes, rules and drawing procedures.
2. Promotion drawings will occur on or about the following days for the listed prizes:

3. The prize of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) will be awarded at an event to be determined by the Hoosier Lottery.
 - a. Details of the drawing event will be available to the five (5) selected winners at the time they are notified during the prize notification and awarding process.
 - b. Participation in the one million dollar (\$1,000,000) drawing event may require in-state travel.
 - c. Each promotion winner will be required to participate in publicity and marketing efforts in association with the one million dollar (\$1,000,000) drawing event.
 - d. In the event a promotion winner is unable to attend the one million dollar (\$1,000,000) drawing event, the promotion winner may assign a proxy, who is eighteen (18) years of age or older, no later than fourteen (14) days prior to the event. The promotion winner shall receive any prizes won by the proxy.
 - e. If neither a promotion winner nor a proxy is willing to participate in the one million dollar (\$1,000,000) drawing event, an alternate will be awarded the prize and named as one of the five finalists for drawing event.

D. ELIGIBILITY

1. This Promotion is open to players eighteen (18) years of age or older who have a current **mylottery** account in good standing.
2. A player may enter the Promotion more than once as long as each entry is with a unique non-winning qualified scratch-off ticket. However, only one (1) prize per household will be allowed.
3. State Lottery Commission of Indiana members, officers, and employees, and any relative(s) residing in the same household of such Hoosier Lottery member, officer, or employee are not eligible to participate in this Promotion.
4. Members, directors, officers, or employees of a major procurement vendor of the Hoosier Lottery, including IGT Indiana, LLC, and any relative(s) residing in the same household of such persons are not eligible to participate in this Promotion.
5. Owners, officers, directors, or employees of licensed Hoosier Lottery retailers may not enter tickets sold at any retail location where they are employed or have management responsibilities.

E. HOW TO ENTER

1. To enter, a player must go to hoosierlottery.com and sign into their **mylottery** account. If a player does not have a **mylottery** account, they must select "sign up now" to register and complete the **mylottery** account sign up, **which is free**.
2. The player must follow the instructions for entering non-winning \$30 All Cash Millions (Limited) Scratch-off ticket(s). For the purposes of this Promotion, a "non-winning ticket" is defined as a ticket, validly purchased from a Hoosier Lottery retailer location or purchased or received directly from the Hoosier Lottery, which does not have a winning prize combination. The player must enter from the front of the ticket the 6-character alphanumeric entry code found under the scratch-off material covering the game play data area.
3. An automated "Thank You" page will notify the player of a completed entry into the Promotion. The "Thank You" notification is only evidence that an entry has been received and does not indicate that the entry is valid.
4. All non-winning tickets whose numbers are submitted as a Promotion Entry **must be retained**. In order to claim a prize, the entrant will be required to submit the eligible

ticket to the Hoosier Lottery. The ticket must be intact and must not be mutilated, defaced, damaged, altered, reconstituted or tampered with in any manner.

5. Each entry must contain current and valid information. The Hoosier Lottery will not change or update entry information for an entry that has already been submitted.
6. All entries that are submitted in the manner as described in these official rules will be eligible for entry in this Promotion. Hand delivered or mailed in entries will not be accepted for this Promotion and will be deemed invalid and destroyed.
7. There is no limit as to how many tickets can be entered, however; each ticket may only be entered once.

F. ODDS OF WINNING

The odds of winning and being selected as a winner in this Promotion are dependent upon the total number of valid entries entered at the time of a drawing. The five (5) drawn winners participating in the one million dollar (\$1,000,000) drawing event will have a one (1) in five (5) chance at winning one million dollars (\$1,000,000).

G. WINNER ANNOUNCEMENT AND CLAIMING OF PRIZE

1. Winning entries drawn for this Promotion will be notified in writing via email and/or via phone if phone number is provided. Winners who fail to complete and return all requested forms and provide the physical ticket within ten (10) business days will automatically forfeit their prize and the next alternate will be selected.
2. Upon timely presentation of winner information including the physical ticket used for entry, the entry will be validated and eligibility will be verified as described in Section D ("Eligibility").
3. If any entry is disqualified during the initial drawing or in the winner notification process, the next alternate will be contacted by Hoosier Lottery. Alternates have ten (10) business days to respond.
4. After Winner Verification and Winner Authorization are complete, winner information will be posted on hoosierlottery.com.
5. Prizes of five hundred dollars (\$500) may be claimed at Hoosier Lottery Headquarters, Hoosier Lottery Regional Offices, or by mail. The winner of the one million dollar (\$1,000,000) prize must be claimed at Hoosier Lottery Headquarters.
6. The one million dollar (\$1,000,000) prize will be paid as a lump sum payment, no annuity option will be available.
7. For the one million dollar (\$1,000,000) prize, the Lottery is required to determine if a prize winner has an outstanding debt to the state, owes delinquent taxes, or is past due on child support pursuant to IC 4-30-11-11. If a debt is discovered the debt will be paid with the prize winnings and any balance will then be paid to the winner.
8. For the one million dollar (\$1,000,000) prize, the Hoosier Lottery will withhold and deposit on the winners' behalf applicable federal and state income withholding taxes. All other costs, taxes (including all state and federal taxes), fees and expenses associated with the acceptance and use of any element of a prize, which are not paid by the Hoosier Lottery, are the sole responsibility of the winner. The Lottery will provide the winner a W2-G for tax reporting purposes.
9. Each Promotion winner may be required to participate in publicity and marketing efforts. Examples include, but are not limited to, an interview with Hoosier Lottery individuals, television, radio and/or newspaper reporters and/or photographers/videographers. This information may be used in future media, the

Hoosier Lottery's website, in store Point of Purchase materials or other marketing efforts without consent or notice.

H. GENERAL RULES AND PROVISIONS

1. The rules and procedures set forth in these Official Rules shall govern this Promotion. These rules may be amended at any time by the Executive Director or her designee of the Hoosier Lottery without advance notice.
2. Game may remain on sale after last second chance drawing.
3. The Executive Director or her designee may, at any time, announce a suspension or termination of this Promotion without advance notice and in the Executive Director's sole discretion, at which point no further entries will be accepted and no additional Prizes shall be awarded. The Hoosier Lottery, the Executive Director, nor any employee of the Hoosier Lottery, IGT Indiana or member of the State Lottery Commission of Indiana, shall have any liability whatsoever for any such termination.
4. By participating in the Promotion each person agrees to comply with and abide by Indiana law, rules, and regulations as well as the terms and conditions of the Lottery website and all final decisions, policies, or procedures of the Hoosier Lottery in relation to the conduct of this Promotion. Any dispute arising which relates to any aspect of this Promotion shall be governed by the laws of Indiana.
5. The Hoosier Lottery and its agents are not responsible for error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operations, theft or destruction, unauthorized access to or alterations of entry materials, failure to receive entry, winner information, or other contest information for any reason whatsoever.
6. The Hoosier Lottery is not responsible for issues with **mylottery** account accessibility or Promotion entries due to technical problems associated to software, hardware compatibility or internet access.
7. By entering this Promotion, all Promotion participants agree to indemnify, hold harmless, and waive any claims against the Hoosier Lottery, including IGT, and any of their affiliates, associates, directors, officers, agents, representatives and assigns arising directly or indirectly, out of, or in any way connected with, this Promotion or the prizes awarded in connection therewith.
